As Director of Academic Services for Calvert Education Services (CES), Kelly Painter oversees all development and revision of course offerings and is a vital part of Calvert's strategic planning, providing an educator's point of view. Ms. Painter supervises the department's five Education Counselors, professional teachers who advise and assist homeschoolers by phone and email; the nearly 100 teachers in the Advisory Teaching Service (ATS), and curriculum writers. A teacher at heart, Ms. Painter continues to serve with her staff in all these capacities on a limited basis. She also works closely with the Publications staff of editors, word processors, and graphic designers in curriculum and marketing matters.

Ms. Painter had been the Interim Director of Academic Services since July 2000, before accepting the permanent position in July 2001.

Ms. Painter joined Calvert in 1993, serving as an Education Counselor since 1994, and as an ATS teacher for seventh and eighth grades. She was also involved in the launch of Calvert's computer-based ATS program.

Ms. Painter came to Calvert with an extensive teaching and coordinating background in grades 5–12, in both private and public schools. Her experience included teaching social studies at the St. Thomas More School in Allentown, Pa.; the Bais Yaakov School for Girls in Baltimore; Hill High School in Winston-Salem, N.C.; and Rudlin Torah Academy in Richmond, Va. (where she also taught math). Additionally, she coordinated the Social Studies curriculum at St. Thomas More, and chaired the Social Studies Department at Hill.

Ms. Painter received her M.A. in Leadership of Teaching from the College of Notre Dame of Maryland, and graduated cum laude with a B.A. in History from Salem College in Winston-Salem, NC.
